Howlin' Wolf recorded "The Red Rooster" in 1961, a song credited to blues arranger and songwriter Willie Dixon.

A variety of performers have interpreted it, including Sam Cooke, Willie Mabon, The Doors, and The Rolling Stones.

The original recording of Dixon performing, has no quick IV turn around at the first verse and last when he is not singing. Also this original key has been transposed by other artists to open G tuning to accept slide guitar, and also in C and A.
